Daniel 9 Notes

"Sevens" = Heptad = Week of years or a seven year period of time

70 sevens or 70 weeks of years or 490 years of prophecy is determined on the people of Israel

From the time of the command "to go and restore Jerusalem, until Messiah" comes will be... 7 weeks (49 years) plus 62 weeks (434 years) or a total of 483 years

You multiply your years by 360 day calendars, not 365 and you come up with 173, 880 days (69 X 7 X 360)

The Date to Start Counting??? – The Degree of Artaxerxes – March 5th 444 BC

And you arrive, 173, 880 days later at March 29th 33 AD – the Day Jesus entered Jerusalem

After that Day the Jews rejected their Messiah and God began to work with a new group of people made up of Jews and Gentiles, known as the church - The 490 year prophecy of Daniel 9 was put on hold after 483 years – leaving one 7 year period yet to be fulfilled – that 7 year period is known as the Great Tribulation

According to Luke (3:1), John the Baptist began his ministry in the 15th year of Tiberius' reign (29 AD). Jesus began His ministry shortly thereafter

Passover dates during the ministry of Jesus

Passover of 29 AD fell on a Sunday (April 17th)
Passover of 30 AD fell on a Thursday (April 6th)
Passover of 31 AD fell on a Tuesday (March 27th)
Passover of 32 AD fell on a Monday (April 14th)
Passover of 33 AD fell on a Friday (April 3rd) –
Fox News Article confirms date 5/24/12
Passover of 34 AD fell on a Tuesday (March 23rd)
Passover of 35 AD fell on a Monday (April 11th)
Passover of 36 AD fell on a Friday (March 30th)
Passover of 37 AD fell on a Thursday (April 18th)

After the 483 years...

Messiah shall be "cut off" – killed for a capital offense – He was

Jerusalem will be destroyed by the people of the prince who is to come – (Rome/Antichrist) –

Jerusalem was destroyed by Rome in 70AD
